Since opening at our new location at Swansea Elementary School:

- We have assisted 81 families with clothing
- We have 83 participants enrolled in English and GED classes
- 77 families with hygiene products
- 30 families with diapers and wipes
- 228 families with backpacks
- A total of 522 plus services have been provided for families
- A total of \$9,494.69 distributed for Energy Assistance

# Classes

### Play & Learn (Spanish)

We are partnering with Clayton Early learning to provide early literacy support classes for children under the age of 3 and their parents.

### **Parenting (Spanish)**

We are partnering with Vuela for Salud to provide a 4 part parenting classes at Swansea every Saturday at 9am

### **Financial Literacy (Spanish)**

We are partnering with CHASE bank to host a 2 part financial literacy class in Spanish.

### GED (Spanish/English )

## Services

### Energy Outreach Colorado

We partner with Energy Outreach Colorado to pay up to \$2,000 in energy assistance per a family per a year.

#### **Dental Clinic**

Once per a month we are partnering with Clinica Tepeyac to provide free of cost dental services for DPS families.

### **Clothing & Hygiene Products**

Our clothing and hygiene product boutique is up and running. All DPS families are eligible to receive clothing items, hygiene products, and diapers at our boutique once per a month.

#### **MLE Referrals**

Our Multilingual education liaison works from our office to connect new to country families with the right school fit.

### **SNAP/Medicaid Referrals**

Every Tuesday we have a representative here to assist families applying for government benefits.

### Workforce Assistance

We have a workforce coordinator on site to help individuals apply for jobs
